



FIRE BELLIED BOMBINA TOAD care sheet



PET DEPOT

CAGING NEEDED

5 gallon terrarium or "critter-keeper" with secure lid. Hiding areas consisting of bark and branches.

BEDDING & WATER NEEDS

Coconut fiber or other soil-like substrate (Advised not to use mulch/wood chips because they might get stuck in the frog's throat when eating). Use a water bowl for toad to submerge in. Add dechlorinated water. Soil should be moist, not wet. A canister filter is needed to keep the habitat clean.

LIGHTING & UVB

They do not require lighting or heater.

TEMPERATURES & HUMIDITY

Room temperature is fine but ideally should range from 65°F to 72°F. Temperatures 82°F or higher is dangerous. Mist daily. Keep environment moist.

DIET

Live gut-loaded crickets and worms. Sprinkle food with calcium daily and with a mineral supplement once or twice a week.

MISC. INFORMATION

Fire Bellied toads spend time in and prefer to float in shallow water. They enjoy being kept in groups, although a single toad can be kept happily by itself. A standard setup incorporates a landing area that slopes down into the water. The simplest approach is to fill 1 to 2 inches of water in a large reptile bowl, treated with water conditioner.

AVERAGE SIZE

2 to 3 inches.

LIFE SPAN

10-15+ years.
